


Memorable AMIS Journeys

Our **Memorable AMIS Journeys** demonstrate the impact we have made to the challenges our customers face and how we have provided practical, pragmatic and powerful solutions for them to address.

- An MCP client in the aerospace industry increased output by 20% and achieved improvements in equipment efficiency from 78% to 90%. The programme, involving just one piece of equipment and training for 12 people, achieved real savings of £100,000 a year.
- ► MCP helped a paper mill to increase its 70% efficiency to an 85% rating - World-Class performance. MCP identified the need for continuous improvement workshops to include shift co-ordinators, team leaders and day support staff. Staff were trained to implement changes aimed at solving inconsistent performance and breakdown problems.
- A successful project for a company in the printing industry identified potential benefits of £1 million a year. Thirty people were trained to run Asset Care projects, ultimately justifying an increase in the number of equipment operators and dramatically increasing output.

- A cost of non-conformance exercise for a company in the chemical sector identified potential benefits of more than £7 million - this came from a reduction in downtime of 10%. A project plan for phased improvements involving a range of tools, techniques and training programmes delivered this huge saving.
- A US global manufacturer was suffering from poor output. Loss of skills, inadequate reporting methods with breakdowns under 15 minutes not being recorded - and slow shift changes contributed to the loss in output. As a result of MCP's problem-solving approach, production efficiency immediately increased to 81%. This was supported by a programme of training which led to further significant improvements.
- ► Following The AMIS Assessment which revealed production inefficiencies, a major US food processing company improved its production efficiency via a range of planned projects and supported training programmes. These improvements were valued at an impressive \$50,000 per day.
